A Theatre That Educates and Unites

Family Theatre was created to address the challenges posed by cultural and educational poverty, which were exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. Family theatre becomes a tool to educate, engage, and inspire younger generations through meaningful stories and accessible performances.

Project Objectives

- 1. Analysis and Research: We will gather data and practices on family theatre across Europe, culminating in the report *Mapping Family Theatre in Europe*.
- 2. Developing a New Format: We will define and test a model of Family Theatre adaptable to diverse European contexts.
- 3. Building an International Network: We aim to connect professionals and theatres, ensuring the sustainability and innovation of the sector.

A Project Spanning Europe

Project activities will take place in Italy, Hungary, Croatia, and Ireland, offering a European and multidisciplinary perspective. During the testing phase, each partner will produce a performance reflecting the characteristics of Family Theatre, involving families and local stakeholders to ensure inclusivity and relevance.

First Steps: Kick-Off in Budapest

The project officially launched during the kick-off meeting held in Budapest from November 4–7, hosted by Insite Drama. It was an opportunity to share ideas, set goals, and kick-start this initiative.

Through interactive workshops, the creation of a shared manifesto, and an audience-oriented approach, Family Theatre aims to transform family theatre into an educational and inclusive experience ready to meet contemporary needs.
